Discussion ensued regarding the various factors putting a sinking fund issue on the August or November 2015 ballot. Consensus of the Board to put this issue on the November 2015 ballot.

Woodworth Elementary Principal Jim Dell said approximately 20-25% students have had discipline incidents this year. Eleven students have been suspended this year. Most of these suspensions are a result of physical aggression.

Leslie Middle School Principal Carol Franz said 12 students have had suspensions this year. Non-compliance and not following directions are the main reasons for disciplinary action.

Leslie High School Principal Scott Powers said 20 students have had suspensions this year. Defiance and non-compliance are the main reasons for disciplinary action.

Supt. Manthei presented further information after meeting with a Leslie Youth Football representative. Discussion ensued about schedules, fees and player participation. An action item will be on the April 20, 2015 agenda.

Lewis & Knopf Accountant Kim Lindsay shared with Supt. Manthei four possible suggestions for restructuring the Business/Finance Office. Consensus of the Board to post the position of Business Manager.

President Isham adjourned the meeting at 8:04 p.m.
