1) Finance Report

Business Manager Anita Strong reported that the sinking fund revenue is coming in slowly, with the expectation that most of it will be deposited by mid-March. Ms. Strong also gave an update on the child care budget and explained the need to approve the audit firm.

2) Sinking Fund Update

Facility Director Troy James said the soil boring results haven't been received. A meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, Feb. 15 with Kingscott. In addition, Mr. James reported that one section of the Woodworth roof needs an emergency repair.

3) Committee Reports

- Math Committee

Supt. Manthei reported that the Math Committee has met three times looking at a new math curriculum for Woodworth. Their recommendation is to purchase GoMath.

- District Advisory Committee

Supt. Manthei said they discussed the Title I report at the last DAT meeting. At the next meeting, the discussion will include the GoMath recommendation.

- Wellness Committee

Board Trustee T. Sears said most of the discussion was about procedure. Decision not to change any policy now because of the possibility of other changes coming soon.

- Positive Culture Committee

Board Trustee T. Sears said this committee needs to meet yearly. Changes may be coming in the student handbook regarding restraint and seclusion. Discussion ensued regarding the possibility of including language and definitions about anti-predatory and bullying behavior.
