 Professional Development Trip to Germany

High School Teachers Jean Maiville and Andrea Weaver applied for a grant which included ten days in Germany. No Leslie Public Schools money was used for this professional development. The Sustainability Study Tour 2015 encouraged two teachers (STEM and German) from each district to attend. 58 teams applied and 10 teams from nine states were chosen. This was sponsored by the Goethe-Institut out of Chicago. Environmental classroom work and encouraging students to work together were mentioned as highpoints of the trip.

 proudly announced that six students from
 IVHS graduated this year and that 15
 classes were passed successfully.
 Emphasizing the numerous ways he

 are 14 students in IVHS, of which
 three students are seniors.
