3) Food Services Update

Food Service Director Kristen Hawkins reported numbers for the summer breakfast and lunch program. Meals were served Tuesday through Thursday for six weeks. Programs served were Middle School Reaching Higher, Woodworth Summer School, Woodworth Daycare and walk-ins. Ms. Hawkins said today (Monday, Sept. 21) was the first day of the after-school free meal program at Leslie High School. This program offers a free cold meal to any student involved in an after-school enrichment activity. This program starts Wednesday, Sept. 23 at Leslie Middle School.

Business Manager Anita Strong reported the auditors were here for four days in late August. They are e-mailing her with a few follow-up questions. Recently two pcards have been compromised. New cards have been issued. Ms. Strong also reported that due to a new Board policy, employee paychecks either be direct deposited into checking accounts or a payroll debit card will be issued. Communication efforts have begun with employees so that this change will be effective January 1, 2016.
